

• **The Connector** – Rated Moderate (requires 4x4 and trail / all terrain tires)

The Connector is the primary trail that will travel through the Sandy Bottom Trail System. It is a 5.1 miles trail that passes through 2 different creeks and will eventually end up on High Knoll Road. This trail will serve as the Connector to New Tate Mill Trail and Pool's Pass. The two requirements to ride this trail is that the Jeep must be 4 wheel Drive and the tires must be trail or all terrain rated.

• New Tate Mill – Rated Moderate (requires 4x4 and trail / all terrain tires)

New Tate Mill runs directly off of the Connector trail at approximately the midpoint. This trail will take you us a winding terrain that will lead you to Old Tate Mill Road. While traveling on this trail, you will have more difficult hill climb options that will require slightly larger tires and you will want to have disconnects and lockers, but the primary trail is easily accessible. The two requirements to ride this trail is that the Jeep must be 4 wheel Drive and the tires must be trail or all terrain rated.

• **Pool's Pass** – Rated Moderate (requires 4x4 and trail / all terrain tires)

Also located off of the Connector trail, Pools Pass travels through another creek crossing and then gives a variety of hill climb options for moderate or difficult routs. The trail does have a very nice uphill section on the primary trail but easier side trails will be marked as well. The two requirements to ride this trail is that the Jeep must be 4 wheel Drive and the tires must be trail or all terrain rated.

• CJ's Hill Pass – Rated Extreme (requires a minimum of 33" trail tires... lockers may be necessary. CJs Hill Pass starts as a gradual trail through the beautiful Long Swamp Creek valley and meanders across the creek. After it lulls you into a peaceful trail ride, you will encounter a very steep uphill slope that will test your wheeling skills. This trail is not recommended for a novice driver.

• Located directly across from Homebase is the entrance to Will's Hills, Wayne's World and Martha's Vineyard – These trails are rated difficult because of the challenging up and down hill sections that will test your wheeling skills.

Signage will be placed to guide you to each of these locations.

To the Trail Head from BaseCamp — The entrance will be from Dragon Drive and it also contains a variety of trails. It will be required to remain in 4 wheel drive to pass through these trails.
