


To the Trail Head from BaseCamp —

9 min (4.1 miles) via Hwy 53 E and Harrington Rd Fastest route

Sheriff's JeepFest

- Head east on Hwy 53 E toward Old Harbin Rd 1.5 mi
- Turn right onto Harrington Rd 17 mi
- Slight right onto Duckett Ln 0.2 mi
- Turn right onto Fortner Rd
 Destination will be on the right



Fortner Loop trails

The Fortner Trail System is made up of a variety of trails ranging from Moderate 4x4 to difficult/extreme.

• Fortner Loop Trail – Rated Moderate – trail rated tires and 4 wheel drive

Fortner Loop is 5.4 miles through the forest that will take you from the end of Fortner Road to Harrington Road. The trail consists of some moderate hill climbs and one small brook crossing. It ends with a new downhill trail that will test your ability to steer the Jeep, but is a great thrill.

• Long Swamp Creek 1 – Rated Difficult – needs a minimum of 33" tires and 4 wheel drive

Long Swamp Creek 1 is a new trail that runs off of Fortner Loop and eventually ends up in Nelson Georgia. This trail crosses the beautiful Long Swamp Creek and has a challenging uphill stretch to wrap it up.

• Long Swamp Creek 2 – Rated Extreme – Not for a beginning Jeeper!

After you complete the incredible Long Swamp Creek 1 Crossing and hill climb, if you are looking for a more extreme hill climb, you can utilize Long Swamp Creek 2 with an extremely challenging hill climb after crossing back over the Long Swamp Creek. The hill features loose rock that will test the skill of any Jeeper. The trail will run back into Fortner Loop, giving you the option to either travel the rest of the loop and end on Harrington Road or loop back through Long Swamp Creek 1 to Nelson.
